The Basic Skills are the fundamentals of the sport of Figure Skating. Each level of the program introduces the fundamental moves: forward skating, backward skating, stops, edges, crossovers, turns and Mohawks. Upon completion of each level, the skater should be equipped with the necessary knowledge and technique to advance to the next level.

General Policies

Students should be warmly but comfortably dressed wearing a warm-up suit or sweat suit, jacket and gloves or mittens. Skates should be properly fitted and tied snugly - the ankles should be supported when standing still. Check with your coach or our ice guard staff if you require assistance with skate fitting.

We request that all observers sit in the bleachers or in the Warm Puppy Café at all times during lessons. This rule must be enforced as we find that students learn better in a quiet, organized and structured setting. Please do not make the teachers leave their classes in order to ask observers to leave. The safety of all skaters is our main concern and if skaters are looking for their parents, they tend to fall and hit the skater next to them. PLEASE HELP US TO ENFORCE THIS RULE FOR THE SAFETY AND LEARNING OF ALL SKATERS.

Absence & Make up classes

Make up classes are not available due to the disruptive nature of new additions to a class midway through a set. In lieu of makeup classes each student receives a Practice Makes Perfect Pass that is good for reduced admission on any public session allowing students time to practice. Refunds are available only on withdrawal from the series before the third lesson in the set.
